Julie Erkel Hagee read her faith statement and shared tails of her faith journey. She answered questions from the floor of presbytery. The presbytery voted to approve her ordination.

The motion to approve the ordination of Julie Erkel Hagee carried. Her call to Ames Collegiate was approved. It was moved to approve her terms of call of \$80,842. They were approved.
