Then the Moderator of the Nominating Committee, Rev. Kerry Carson, placed in nomination for election Rev. Kristin Pike as Stated Clerk for a one-year term. Rev. Pike was elected effective July 1, 2019. Terms of call are salary \$10,506; SECA \$803.71; Continuing Ed \$1500.

Elder Beth Ehlers, CP reported on the recommendation of the search committee for the Temporary Supply General Presbyter to be shared with the Presbytery of Prospect Hill effective May 16, 2019

Rev. Ian McMullen was placed in nomination. The call of Rev. McMullen was approved with associated terms of call.

It was moved and seconded to approve the sharing of a Personnel Committee with the Presbytery of Prospect Hill. North Central Iowa members are: Brad Braley, Judy Klepfer, Jean Bower and Gordon Moen. The motion carried.

Rev. Kerry Carson reported for the Nominating Committee. The committee moved the election of the Rev. Dr. Tricia Jacobs to the Commission on Ministry, term to expire in 2021. The motion carried.

The committee moved to elect the Rev. Dr. Austin Hill to the Commission on Ministry, term to expire in 2020. The motion carried.

The Moderator, Elder Judy Klepfer, welcomed announcements.

The Moderator, Elder Judy Klepfer, adjourned the meeting with a closing prayer. Then the commissioners had a reception in honor of Rev. Dr. Glenn Wilson with a cake the said "Thanks Glenn!" Wilson was given a gift of Corinthian Bells wind chimes to commemorate his service.
